



THE NATIONAL HOTEL CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The National Hotel strives to be a safe and inclusive space where all patrons can feel welcome.

The right of admission is reserved and is subject to this code of conduct, liquor licensing laws and the terms and conditions agreed to at time of purchase irrespective of that person being in possession of a valid ticket for an event.

Responsible Service of Alcohol legislation applies to all patrons.

Government Health Orders apply to all patrons, contractors and staff.

Harassment or aggressive behaviour will result in your removal from the venue.

Entry to the venue is not permitted to persons under 18 years of age unless in the company of a responsible adult.

Valid ID must be shown upon entry to the venue even if you have a pre-purchased ticket for an event.

You may have your bag checked on entry, prohibited items include but are not limited to; weapons, alcohol, spray paint.

Footwear must be worn at all times.

You consent to being filmed by our CCTV systems in line with licensing requirements. You consent to being filmed or have your picture taken for the purposes of marketing, and publicity by the venue or artists.

10% Surcharge will be applied to food and drink purchases on Public Holidays, the venue reserves the right to alter prices.

Tagging or graffiti will not be tolerated and will result in your removal from the venue.

COVID SAFETY

The National Hotel is operating within the Hospitality Industry Guidelines as set out by the Victoria Department of Health, and the venue's CovidSafe Plan.

The venue reserves the right to refuse entry to those who they believe are in breach of the Government Health Orders for Metropolitan Melbourne.

This may include, but is not limited to; refusing to provide proof of vaccination, presenting to the venue with symptoms of Covid19 as reasonably determined by the venue staff, refusing to provide contact details, refusing to check in, refusing to maintain physical distance and refusing to behave in a safe manner.

QR Code check-ins are mandatory for the purposes of contact tracing.

A fitted face mask may be required to be worn in the venue.

The National Hotel reserves the right to request for a mask to be removed in order to confirm ID for entry and the supply of alcohol.
